

PRIVACY POLICY

As required per Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), we hereby inform that:

This Privacy Policy sets out ways of using and protecting personal information of Customers using a customer application for designing and ordering kitchen countertops on the website www.blaty.panmar.pl, hereinafter referred to as "Customer Application - Countertop Configurator".

THE CONTROLLER OF CUSTOMER'S PERSONAL DATA

The Controller of the personal information of the Customers using the website www.blaty.panmar.pl is the company **PANMAR Czekańska Szmyd Spółka Jawna**, registered at ul. Podkarpacka 16B, 38-400 Krosno, Tax ID Number (NIP) 684-00-08-202, National Business Registry Number (REGON) 370009017, District Court in Rzeszów XII Commercial Division, National Court Register (KRS) No: 0000004314 hereinafter referred to as „Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j.”.

THE METHOD OF DATA COLLECTION

The Customer's personal data are provided voluntarily by the users of the website www.blaty.panmar.pl seeking to use the design services offered therein and to order kitchen countertops. Failure to provide specific data may limit the possibility of using the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator. These data are processed on the basis of the Customer's consent, which is granted by the Customer ticking an appropriate box on the order form and the registration form of an individual Customer Account.

Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j., collects customer data such as full name, company name, e-mail address, delivery address, country, telephone number. When a Customer opens an individual Customer Account on the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator he/she may be asked to provide additional information such as the Company name, tax ID number and phone/fax number.

COOKIES

When using the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator, the Customer agrees on the use of cookies in order for him/her to be provided with comfort while browsing the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator page. None of the cookies used on the websites of the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator collect information that allow for the user identification.

What are cookies?

In today's world, virtually every website uses cookies. They consist of small text files stored on the user's terminal equipment. They are created by the User's computer's web browser and store the settings and information needed (and often necessary) for a proper operation of the website. During subsequent visits to the website on the same device the browser can check if there are cookies that

store important information and send it back to the visited site, which has previously registered a cookie on your device. Thus the site can recognize that you have visited it before and for example match the content presented to the recipient.

Advantages of cookies

Cookies facilitate the use of websites previously visited by the User. If you use the same device and browser as before, it allows for remembering your preferences and a proper display of the web page tailored to your individual needs. Cookies allow us to create statistics that help to understand how Users use the website, which enables us to improve its structure and content. They also allow for keeping the session of the Website's User (after logging in), so that each successive sub-page of the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator does not require re-login.

Controlling and removing cookies

You may change the way the cookies are used at any time. Most browsers offer an option to accept or reject all cookies, accept only certain types of cookies or to inform the User every time a website attempts to save them. The user can also easily delete cookies that have already been stored on the device by the browser. Possibilities to manage and delete cookies vary depending on the browser used. You may find all the necessary information using the Help function in your browser or by visiting the website <http://www.aboutcookies.org/>, which explains how to control and delete cookies in the most popular browsers. Keep in mind that blocking all cookies may result in difficulties in the operation or altogether prevent the use of some functionalities of the website.

The Customer Application - Countertop Configurator page uses cookies, which can be divided into:

- Session cookies - they operate only when browsing the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator pages thus enabling their proper functioning. They are also used by the server to store information about the activities, if the connection with the server is broken, the User can come back to the same place on the site.
- Permanent Cookies - they remain on the device after visiting the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator, which means the Shop can remember the User's settings during subsequent visits. Thanks to this the Shop becomes easier to navigate and saves the User's preferences.
- Cookies placed by external entities - they allow for customizing the displayed web page to the User's preferences when purchases are made.

THE PURPOSE OF DATA COLLECTION

Any data provided by the Customer will be processed by Panmar Czeakańska Szmyd Sp. j. to execute the order and for the Customer to use individual Customer Account, but also to ensure contact between the Customer and Panmar Czeakańska Szmyd Sp.j., and to inform the Customer about the products, services and promotions of Panmar Czeakańska Szmyd Sp. j. and to assert claims arising under or in connection with the transaction of business, in so far as it does not violate the provisions of the Art 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR) .

Depending on the consent granted by the Customer, the provided personal data, and in particular the e-mail address and mobile phone number can be used by Panmar Czeakańska Szmyd Sp. j. to send a free newsletter containing commercial information within the meaning of the Act of 18 July 2002 on the provision of electronic services (Journal Of Laws 2019.0.123_t.j.) Consent for signing up for the newsletter can be revoked at any time. For this purpose, please send an e-mail to the address: blaty@panmar.pl with the message: "Withdrawal from the newsletter"

Shared Customer's personal data will be stored for a maximum period of 5 to 6 years (due to the requirements of the Accounting Act) or until an objection to the processing of personal data is raised by the Customer for reasons related to the Customer's particular situation.

THE RIGHT OF ACCESS

The Customer has a possibility to decide to what extent his personal information will be used. The Customer has the right to amend, update or rectify his/her personal data, to require a temporary or permanent suspension of processing or removal his/her data if it is incomplete, outdated, untrue or collected in violation of the law or is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was collected, and the right to object, in the cases referred to in Article 13 paragraph 2 point b of GDPR when Panmar Czeakańska Szmyd Sp. j. intends to process the Customer's data for marketing purposes, or transfer it to another data controller.

Customers can make any changes in the scope of their data by sending a proper declaration of intent to the address blaty@panmar.com or to the company address PANMAR Czeakańska Szmyd Spółka Jawna, ul. Podkarpacka 16B, 38-400 Krosno.

Panmar Czeakańska Szmyd Sp. j. reserves the right to refuse to remove the Customer's data, if its retention is necessary to enforce claims, or if required by the applicable law.

RECORDING, PROTECTION AND SHARING THE CONTENT OF AGREEMENTS

The Customer may obtain access to this Privacy Policy (or the Terms and Conditions) at any time via a link placed on the Customer Application - Countertop Configurator page – www.blaty.panmar.pl as well as download it and print it.

The relevant provisions of the contract for sale of goods and services shall be recorded, secured, shared and confirmed to the Customer upon sending to the Customer a printed confirmation, order specifications or the receipt (invoice) to the provided e-mail address and upon joining these documents to the parcel containing the order.

Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j. declares that it processes the Customers' personal data in accordance with Article 13 paragraph 1 and 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ of EU L 119, dated 04/05/2016, p. 1), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR" and that it uses technical and organizational measures to ensure the protection of the processed data adequate to the risks and category of data being protected, in particular, protects the Customers' personal details from sharing them with unauthorized persons, from loss or damage.

SHARING THE CUSTOMERS' PERSONAL DATA WITH THIRD PARTIES

Personal data collected by Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j. can be directly accessed only by authorized employees or business associates of Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j. and by authorized persons servicing the website of Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j., who have been granted the appropriate authorization.

Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp. j. may share personal information collected from the Customer with the cooperating entities such as shipping companies, companies servicing payments for the execution of the Customer's order, cooperating law firms, entities authorized to access the data under the provisions of law. We will not pass your personal data to third countries.

In such cases the amount of transmitted data is limited to the required minimum. Furthermore, the information the customer has provided may be disclosed to the competent public authorities, if required by applicable law.

INFORMATION CLAUSE

Based on the Art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR) we hereby inform that:

The Controller of your personal data is PANMAR Czekańska Szmyd Sp.j., You can contact us by writing to the address ul. Podkarpacka 16 B, 38-400 Krosno.

Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of conclusion and service of agreements, as well as maintaining business contacts. Transfer of personal data is voluntary, but necessary to conclude an agreement and maintain business relationships.

The legal basis for the processing of your data is the conclusion of an agreement, the provisions of the Accounting Act of 29 September 1994 and a legitimate interest of PANMAR Czekańska Szmyd Sp.j., which is to maintain business relationships.

In regard to the processing of your personal data you are entitled to appeal to the President of Personal Data Protection Office.

Based on your personal data we will not take automated decisions on you, nor the decisions resulting from profiling.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY

Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp.j. is not liable for the acts or omissions of the Customers, in the effect of which Panmar Czekańska Szmyd Sp.j. processes the personal information provided by them in the manner described in this Privacy Policy.
